

FOOTPATHS

Throughout the year most of the footpaths have remained in good condition.

Suffolk County Council have continued to cut the surface of a small number of paths twice per year. This is typically carried out in late April and late September each year.

The majority of paths however are maintained by land owners and a number of local residents who give up their time to volunteer to keep the paths accessible and free from overhanging foliage.

Most recently volunteers have repaired signposts on footpaths 4 and 14. and large sections of footpaths 10 and 14 have been laid with wood chippings.

Two more signposts have rotted on the Hall Farm section of footpath 4 and will need replacing.

Two large trees have fallen over footpath 2 near Woolpit Road. The path is still useable but Suffolk County Council have been contacted as at some point this may become a risk. They have contacted the landowner and are working to resolve the situation.
